#### Introduction

Charles Wesley Fitch maintained daily journals or diaries, if you will. We do not know how many remain to this day. This transcription was undertaken to make available to descendants of Grandpa Fitch, these excellent records of life nearly a century ago. We hope that this transcription is only the first of many. Currently we are trying to determine how many of the journals remain and their current where-abouts.

It is our understanding that the journals found after the death of grandpa were divided amongst the surviving children. This journal for 1908 was in obtained by Hazel Marguerite McDonald daughter of Charles. This year being significant to Hazel as she was born on July 16, 1908 and her birth was referenced on that day. Another important happening recorded during this same period is building of the family home on Blundell Road in Riverton Twp. The house was being built on 30 acres on the South side of the road. His father John Henry Fitch lived on 40 acres across the road. Various entries record his progress as he worked and completed portions of the house, eventually adding a barn and stable.

From a genealogical standpoint I have added footnotes that are printed at the end of this transcription. These footnotes attempt to identify members of the family. Many other names are referred to in the Journal and are no doubt recognized by many as individuals prominent in the early history of this area of Mason County. We retained the spellings and punctuations as recorded in the diary, except for adding periods or hypens to separate entries for clarity purposes.

Got up at 3 - started to town at 4

Left town at 7 - changed cars at Baldwin at 8:15 am. Crops froze badly between baldwin and Grand Rapids. Changed at Grand Rapids at 11 am. Ate our lunch. Arived at detroit at 3.

Mailed postals home.

Went to belle Isle on boat.

Got back to Detroit at 7 o'clock. Ate our supper. walked around town, took train at 11:40 for Woodstock. Willie had a good sleep. I tried to sleep with one shoe off and one on.

We got to woodstock at 5:15 a.m. Stayed around town till 9:30. Walked out to Unkles<sup>19</sup>. Ate our dinner on our way under a tree. Unkle was awayfishing. We meet him near barn yard tried to hire to him. We went down to river in after noon. We went to bed at 10.

Got up at 7.

We drove 16 miles saw four stone houses. All kinds of good farms.

Sept 7

We got up at 2.30

Started to walk to town at 4 - took the 5:20 train for Toronto - we saw seven or more Stone houses from train windows. O[u]r train consists of 9 coaches - landed at fair 9:15.

Saw white yorkshires- 1015 lb- 175 small pens..

From Grandstand we saw Bear Dance,

drink out of the bottle while sitting in chair, kiss man, telephone weasel, man throwed bear, bear throughed man, rode tricycle. Cub rolled over, slide on wire, Roll Ball, Thre ebears eat off table.Drink out of bottles, Cub lays on back to drink.

Four Elephant stood on head, walked with front feet on head ones back.Man hung trapice<sup>20</sup> on trunk and swang. Played ball. Layed on man. Man walked on their back, stood on head. They washed and wiped men. Man shot a man and the Elephant carried off.

Cavery drilled

12 ponies parraded

By the proformers

Man danced on rope

One man fell-carried away on stretcher.

Pony fell backwards on top of boy.

Six carriage teams Parrade.

Had an old horseman and woman chase each other through windows through hole in roof.

Lyons preformed.

Horse jumped fence with man on back.

We started for Beaverton at 7:50 with four or five coachs and double header. Changed at Balckwater - arrived at Beaverton 11:30.

#### Trip to Canada

Started home at 5:50 arrived at Toronto 10. missed 10:10 train. Layed in waiting room all night. Left Toronto on the 8 AM train at 8:30.

Throwed a bread wagon off the track. Killed horse. Got to Woodstock at 11:10. [September 8] . Bought our ticket for Detroit- no excitement then till we got to near Windsor when inspector came around to see where we were going and what for. Landed from ferry at 3:30. Went to Fair. Got back from fair at 10:00. [September 9, 1908]

Seen flying maching.

Started home from Detroit at 2:20<sup>21</sup> Changed at Saginaw 6:30-50.
